History of AutoCAD AutoCAD was originally developed by Don Garlick in 1982 for use in architectural drafting and drafting. The first version, AutoCAD Version 1, was the first commercially successful CAD program on the Macintosh. It was originally developed for the Macintosh using an 8-bit PDP-11 processor with hardware-based drafting capabilities. The primary purpose of the original AutoCAD release was to provide an architect with a desktop CAD application, prior to moving to a CAD workstation (previously referred to as a CAD terminal or CAD workstation). Version 1 was an interpreter that implemented a functional programming language with three main data types (numbers, text and graphics) and basic commands.

Version 1 ran on a Macintosh Plus with 640K of RAM, a 12 MHz 68030 microprocessor, 4Mb of internal RAM and a 5.25 inch floppy disk drive. Version 1 was also marketed as Rhapsody and introduced new features, such as an improved drawing library, two-dimensional coordinate space and a pencil tool. This was the first version to be written in C (rather than Basic), and thus supported higher-level constructs such as calls to external procedures. Version 2 and 3 of AutoCAD Version 2 was the first commercial CAD program to provide raster image output, usually in the PostScript (.ps) format. The primary goal of Version 2 was to provide a Macintosh compatible version of the Aldus PageMaker PostScript DTP program. Autodesk's first commercial version of AutoCAD, released in May 1983, was called AutoCAD Version 2. AutoCAD Version 2 was the first version to run on a 68000-based PC or mainframe computer. The 68000 processor was developed by Motorola Inc. and was first introduced in the Model 500 computer. The 68000 offered greater processing capability than the 8-bit PDP-11 and supported higher-level languages, such as C. The main difference between AutoCAD 2 and the original AutoCAD was the addition of object-oriented programming capabilities, using Microsoft's Object Linking and Embedding (OLE). This was done to enable AutoCAD 2 to work with external data and allow the data to be used as parameters for drawing functions. Version 3 was the first version to provide a native data type that could be used as both a coordinate and graphic object. It was also the first version to introduce AutoCAD's user interface as a point-and
